JOHN 16:12-15

SOLEMNITY OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

(Proverbs 8:22-31; Psalm 8; Romans 5:1-5)

KEY VERSE: "But when he comes, the Spirit of truth, he will guide you to all truth" (v 13).

READING: Jesus promised his disciples that

the Holy Spirit would enlighten their minds after he was raised to glory with the Father. The work of Christ would be continued on earth through the indwelling Spirit who would guide the Church to all truth. Just as Jesus only spoke the words he heard from the Father, the Spirit did not speak alone, but interpreted Christ's eternal message of truth for each generation. Since the year 200 CE, the term "Trinity" has been used to denote the central Christian doctrine that God is absolutely one in nature and essence, and is three distinct persons, Father, Son and Holy Spirit, co-eternal and deserving equal honor and glory. This revelation of the Father and Son through the Spirit was transmitted by the apostles and the evangelists through their teaching, example, institutions and writings. This "Apostolic Tradition" has been preserved by the Spirit in the doctrine, worship and the sacraments of the Church.

REFLECTING: In what ways do I teach God's truth to others?

PRAYING: Father, Son and Holy Spirit, illuminate my mind to understand the Church's teachings.

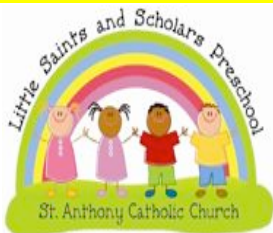

PROPER ATTIRE FOR MASSES

The Liturgy Office has been receiving requests for guidelines on the proper attire in church. The summer season usually sees an increasing number of people who come to church to attend Mass or other liturgical functions dressed in a way that disrespects the sanctity of the House of God and the sacredness of the Liturgical Celebration.

This is a difficult topic. We do not want to suggest that one is not welcome at a Sunday liturgy without expensive clothing-and yet, out

of respect for what we are doing at Mass and as an example for young children, a modicum of propriety is expected.

The goal in dressing for Mass should be not to attract undue attention to oneself. It must be considered that some people, out of necessity, come to Mass wearing the clothes required by their profession, however, under normal circumstances attire should reflect the solemnity of the Mass. One should aim for, "you look nice today," as opposed to "My gosh! Did you see what she or he was wearing today?"

The faithful are advised not to wear caps, tank tops or jersey shorts during Mass. Women are also asked not to wear spaghetti-strap tops, short skirts, skimpy shorts or sleeveless shirts with plunging necklines. Simply put – beach wear, lounge wear, etc. are not appropriate attire.

What we wear says a great deal about what we value. If you are a public minister in the liturgy, a lector, a Eucharistic minister, or a cantor, for example, you should dress with extra care, so that your appearance does not pose a distraction to the worshippers. We usually dress well when we go to things that are important to us, and as Catholics, this is the most important thing that we will do each week. The manner in which the minister dresses is part of the reverence that is shown to the Lord present in the Eucharist as well as respect shown for God's holy people.

"Bodily demeanor (gestures, clothing) ought to convey the respect, solemnity, and joy of the moment when Christ becomes our guest.

MEMORIAL DAY (USA)

"The memory of the righteous will be a blessing."
Proverbs 10: 7 Memorial Day, originally known as Decoration Day, was established in 1868 to commemorate the dead from the Civil War. The first official observance included a program at the National Cemetery at Arlington and memorial services in various communities. General John A. Logan of the Grand Army of the Republic designated May 30, 1868, "as a day for strewing with flowers or otherwise decorating the graves of comrades who died in defense of their country, and whose bodies now lie in almost every city, village, or hamlet churchyard in the land." Memorial Day was expanded after World War I to include American
