## Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time

### June 20, 2010



**LUKE 9:18-24 TWELFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**  
 (Zechariah 12:10-11, 13:1; Psalm 63; Galatians 3:26-29) **KEY VERSE:** "But who do you say that I am?" (v.20).  
**READING:** Jesus had been praying in solitude, and then he asked his disciples who the people believed him to be. They answered that some

thought he was John the Baptist, while others believed him to be Elijah, and still others thought he was one of the ancient prophets that had arisen. Jesus then asked what they personally believed about him. Peter spoke for the Twelve declaring that Jesus was the "Messiah of God" (v 20, in Greek *christos*, the equivalent of the Hebrew term *mashiach* meaning "anointed one"). The title "Messiah" had grown in popularity, and among certain groups, it was applied to a descendant of the royal family of David who would come to restore the kingdom of Israel (Acts 1:6). Jesus told his followers not to reveal his true identity as many would expect a political leader who would set Israel free from foreign oppression. Jesus then taught them about his coming passion and death, and the necessity of the cross for all who would follow him.

**READING:** How can I help others understand who Jesus is?

**PRAYING:** Lord Jesus, you are my Savior, my healer, my liberator, my refuge, my rock, my fortress, my peace and my hope.

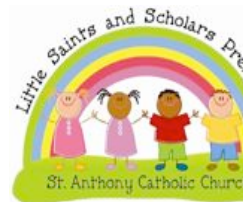

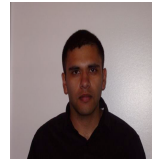
